Invent yourself as an alternative superhero and make a creative presentation of yourself on class using the digital tool of your choice: WeVideo, VoiceThread or BookCreator.

You might prefer to work with a partner presenting your combined superhero persona or a superhero identity and his/her amazing sidekick/helper.

Ideas for your superhero identity:

- What is the name of your superhero identity?
- What superpower do you have and how did you get them?
- What sort of personality will your superhero identity have and how is it different from your alter ego?
- Do your powers have a built-in weakness?
- Do you have a special outfit – a logo, a cape, or a suit?
- Does your hero have a special vehicle?
- Does your hero have a secret headquarters and how is it like?
- Do you have a battle cry/catch phrase?
- Does your hero have a sidekick, and what is his/her story?
- Is your hero fighting evil in general or specific types of evil? A specific nemesis or enemy?

You may include props og objects in your presentation. The same goes for pictures/photos, short film sequences and music from English-speaking countries. However, make sure that they add real value to the quality of your presentation.
